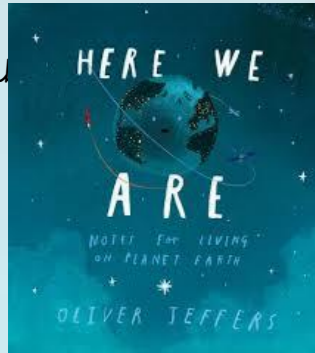


Maths

This term we will be recapping our knowledge from year 1 in number recognition and place value within 20 before moving on to place value and addition and subtraction within 100.

- Number and Place Value: place value, numbers up to 100 in numerals and words, compare and order numbers up to 100 and partitioning.
- Addition and Subtraction: Problem solving using addition and subtraction through number, quantity and measure, addition and subtraction sums, add and subtract a two digit number and ones, add and subtract a two digit number with tens, use addition and subtraction facts to 20 to quickly solve facts to 100.

- Information pages - Sentence types, facts, lists, posters, sentence openers and sentence types.
